

## ANNUAL REPORT 2023-24

Guru Nanak College Killianwali, affiliated with Panjab University Chandigarh, has been serving in the field of education since 1956 under the leadership of Guru Nanak Educational Society (Regd.). The motto of this prestigious institution is Strive Seek Serve. It is the first educational institute in this Malwa region. The college was accredited with Grade 'B+' by NAAC in 2022 with CGPA score 2.66 for the second cycle. IQAC was established in 2015 to develop a system for conscious, consistent and catalytic action to improve the academic and administrative performance of the institution and to promote measures for institutional functioning towards quality enhancement through internalization of quality culture and institutionalization of best practices.

The institution is imparting education in the streams of Arts and Commerce at undergraduate level as well as postgraduate in Commerce. Apart from this, the college has Add-on-Course Computer Based Accounting and Post Graduate Diploma in Computer Applications. It has a huge campus flourished with trees and flowers incorporating modern facilities like E-library, E- Shelf, Multimedia Seminar Hall, Conference Hall, Modern Auditorium, ICT enabled classrooms, Swimming Pool, Gym, Lawn Tennis Court, Badminton Court and Large Sports Ground. The college has also installed solar system in the year 2022 of 13 KW for conservation of energy and adopting an environment friendly approach. The college is fortunate to have a galaxy of eminent personalities in Management under the dynamic leadership of President Major (Retd.) Bhupinder Singh Dhillon, Vice-President S.Gurdial Singh, Secretary Sh. Neeraj Jindal along with dedicated members and qualified faculty and always active Alumni. Paying tribute to our great founder President, college has a sculpture dedicated to S. Gurraj Singh Dhillon (M.P. Sahib) and Babu Nanak Chand Aggarwal Memorial park in the memory of founder Secretary of the college.

In the last year, the results of almost all the classes at the college are remarkable. Coming to students who got 1<sup>st</sup> position in respective classes of 2022-23, Gaganpreet Kaur of M.Com 1st Sem scored 75.29%, Jaspreet Kaur of M.Com 3rd sem scored 85.52%, Vibhor of B.A. 1st Sem scored 77%, Piyush of B.A. 3rd Sem scored 82.47%, Jashandeep Kaur Sidhu of B.A. 5th Sem scored 80.27%, Poorav of B.Com 1st Sem scored 71.88%, Tushar Singla of B.Com 3rd Sem scored 75.5%, and Osheen Monga of B.Com 5th Sem scored 87.67%.

The college aims at the overall development of the students through their participation in extracurricular activities like NCC, NSS, Sports, Youth Festival and other events. The students have also excelled in various state level exams like NET, CTET and PSTET. Students of the college have also participated in PU Zonal Youth and Heritage Festival and got 1<sup>st</sup> position in Bhangra and Jhumar, 2<sup>nd</sup> position in Geet Mukable bagged by Vakeel Chand, 3<sup>rd</sup> position in Hand Writing competition bagged by Ashish William. In this festival, Gurmandeep Singh got 1<sup>st</sup> prize (individual) in Bhangra, Supanpreet Singh and Himanshu Sethi got 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> position (individual) in Jhumar and Anamika got 3<sup>rd</sup> position (individual) in Giddha. In PU Inter-Zonal Youth and Heritage festival, the students of the College also got 2<sup>nd</sup> position in Lok Nach Jhoomar. Supanpreet Singh got first prize (Individual) for Bhangra and Jhumar. In competition organized by Punjabi Folk Dance Virasat Club Malout, College Bhangra Team won third place.

In sports, 4 students participated in PU inter College Annual Athletic Meet from 25.11.2023 to 27.11.2023. In the 67<sup>th</sup> Annual Athletic Meet held on 01.03.2024 & 02.03.2024 arranged by sports committee, Inderpal Singh (BA 2<sup>nd</sup> Year) and Santosh (BA 3<sup>rd</sup> Year) were declared as Best Athletes.

The College is having a joint wing of NCC for boys and girls under the leadership of CTO Mr. Prince Singla and Co-Incharge Mr. Manik Jindal. In the year 2022-23, 11 cadets cleared BEE certificate exam and 9 cadets cleared CEE Certificate exam. The year 2023-24 saw the selection of Under Officer Navdeep Singh (BA 2nd Year) and Santosh (BA 3rd Year) as the top cadets. Sargent Manpreet Singh (BA 2<sup>nd</sup> Year) and Ramandeep Kaur (BA 3<sup>rd</sup> Year) were selected as best in drill.

The NSS unit celebrates various national and international days under the guidance of Programme Officer Mr. Ashish Baghla and Co-Incharge Mrs. Gurbinder Kaur. The students were motivated to develop their social and intellectual skills along with making them aware of our social concerns by celebration of World Ozone Day, World Food Safety Day, Gandhi



Jayanti, World Mental Health Day, International Day of Girl Child, Registration Drive on My Bharat Portal, Extension Lecture on Road Safety, Democracy and Role of Water, Rally on Water awareness, 7 Day NSS Camp on Swachh Bharat Abhiyan. In 2023-24 Vishvas (BA 1<sup>st</sup> year), Anisha (BCOM 3<sup>rd</sup> Year) were selected as best NSS volunteer.

Different departments of the college organized Extension lectures, Quiz Competitions, Creative Writing Competitions and Power Point Presentations in their departments to provide in-depth knowledge and latest changes in their subjects to the students. Every year, Induction Programme, Ice Breaking Session, Freshers' Party and Farewell Party are also organized in the college. To give the practical knowledge to students, Departments also organize Management Games, Workshops, Training Programmes and visits to different Institutions. Apart from this the college annually celebrates Independence Day, Janamashtami, Gurupurab, Republic Day and other days to impart knowledge to students about our heritage and culture.

As far as achievements of the staff members are concerned they constantly work for the quality improvement in their teaching and research related aspects so as to provide better knowledge to their students. College teaching staff along with teaching, has published 1 book, 05 research papers in National-International-level journals, 21 papers in Edited books, presented 14 papers in different National and International seminars, attended 4 Faculty Induction Programmes, 5 Faculty Development Programmes, acted as an interview expert for the selection of teaching faculty and as member of inspection committee in different educational institutions as VC and DCDC Nominee, subject expert as well as UG/PG paper setters. Faculty has prepared the students for cultural programs, extra- curricular activities, competitive exams etc. Four faculty members from our college are pursuing Ph.D. College Principal Dr. Surinder Singh is registered as Ph.D. guide. 5 students have completed Ph.D. under his supervision. It is an honor for the college that the Principal has contributed to assessment of different Colleges as a member of the NAAC Peer team. The Principal is also an Added Member, Faculty of Arts, member of Youth Welfare and Heritage Committee, member of Sports Committee Panjab University Chandigarh and has been Chairman for Inter University Team Selection. Associate Professor Mr. Amit Behal is a member of Board of Studies in Gandhian and Peace Studies, member of Post Graduate Board of Studies in Library Science and also a member of Under Graduate Board of studies in Political Science at Panjab University Chandigarh. Career Counselling and Guidance Cell has organized free coaching classes for competitive exams for the college students. Free coaching classes for 12th pass out students were held to strengthen the basics of Computer, English, Accounts, Maths in the month of May.
